2	 Full day in Ricketts Glen State Park Hike the Falls Trail System. This trail is within the Glens Natural Area and passes 21 waterfalls. Trail guide available here. Go swimming or boating on Lake Jean. Kayak, paddleboard, and rowboat rentals are available in the summer months. 	Ricketts Glen State Park Campground
3	 Arrive to Worlds End State Park Drive to Worlds End State Park (30 minutes). Hike the High Rock Trail, Worlds End Trail, and/or Butternut Trail. Drive to the Loyalsock Canyon Vista overlook. 	Worlds End State Park Campground
